VI. Resolution

Action Resolution Approve Change in Health Insurance Carrier

Resolved, that the Somerset Hills Board of Education approve a change in health insurance carrier per the recommendation of its group insurance broker-of-record, Brown & Brown Benefit Advisors, Inc., the Somerset Hills Board of Education hereby resolves, effective July 1, 2011, to make the following changes to its group insurance program:

- 1. Terminate its group medical insurance policy with Horizon, Group Number 89607.
- 2. Select Oxford Health Plans as its group medical insurance carrier, at the rates, benefits, terms, and conditions represented in their proposal of April 13, 2011.
- 3. Designate Brown & Brown Benefit Advisors, Inc., as the Board's group insurance broker-of-record for our new Oxford Health Plans group medical insurance program. Brown & Brown Benefit Advisors, Inc. is authorized to act on behalf of the Board in all matters related to this program.

Brown & Brown Benefit Advisors, Inc.'s responsibilities will include, but are not limited to, negotiating annual renewal rates, marketing our group insurance programs, and aiding our staff in the resolution of billing, enrollment, and claim problems. Brown & Brown Benefit Advisors, Inc. is authorized to receive commission payments from Oxford Health Plans as compensation for their services, percentages for which are included in Oxford Health Plan's proposed premium rates.

4. All appropriate Board of Education staff are authorized to take such action and affect such documentation as necessary to implement this change.
