WHEREAS, Weichert and the Board of Education wish to memorialize an agreement whereby, if TD Bank, N.A. obtains the necessary approvals from the Bernardsville Planning Board and constructs the Intended Development or other permanent improvements on the Weichert Property, Weichert will construct (or cause to be constructed), and grant and convey to the Board of Education a non-exclusive easement to use, an emergency access driveway for ingress and egress of emergency vehicles between the School Property and U.S. Route 202 and emergency evacuation of Bernards High School;

WHEREAS, the Somerset Hills Board of Education has determined that it is in the best interests of the Somerset Hills School District to enter into such agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Somerset Hills Board of Education, as follows:

- a) The President and Secretary of the Somerset Hills Board of Education are hereby authorized to execute the Emergency Driveway Easement Agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- b) The President and Secretary are authorized to execute all other documents necessary to carry out the terms of this resolution.
