Report of the Superintendent

- 1. Annual Financial Audit. Warren Korecky, Partner Suplee Clooney & Company Mr. Miller introduced Mr. Korecky from Suplee Clooney & Company. Mr. Korecky reviewed the audit report and recommendation on fixed assets. Mr. Korecky and Mr. Miller responded to questions from the Board and public about the audit.
- 2. Report on Strategic Plan Committee. Mr. Miller presented the annual review of year 1 of the Strategic Plan and the implementation overview of Year 2. Mr. Miller thanked the Planning Team. He also emphasized that the Strategic Plan helps us stay focused.
- 3. Report on Student Assessment. Ms.Wilkins presented assessment data. HSPA and NJASK Grade 3-8 Math, Language Arts Literacy and Science where applicable and SAT Scores. She said the district scores are well above DFG and State averages.
- 4. Report on New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC). Mr. Miller presented the NJQSAC and discussed the DPR Self-Assessment Scores:

Fiscal Management 99 of 100 points

Governance 100 of 100 points

Instruction & Program current 72 of 118 points*

anticipated 115 of 118 points

Operations 120 of 120 points Personnel 100 of 100 points

*NJDOE has not provided data for indicators A1-6. Districts have been instructed by NJDOE to leave those indicators blank. Although this reduces the district's self-assessment score in this section to 61%, it is the district's expectation that all of the points for A1-6 will be awarded when the NJDOE provides that information.

5. Code of Student Conduct Report

Mr. Miller reported that there were 602 referrals for the 2008-09 school year. The top eight referrals are as follows: 170 referrals for iPods and cell phones (prohibited items), 63 referrals for tardies, 53 referrals for insubordination, 35 referrals for class misconduct, 34 referrals for cutting central detention,

- referrals for computer misuse, 27 referrals for failing to report to assigned area and 27 referrals for obscene language.
- 6. Student/Staff Recognition. Mr. Miller congratulated Bernard High School teams and their coaches for their recent wins: Girls Cross County Team won the Skyland Division Championship; Girls Soccer Team won the NJSIAA Sectional Championship; Field Hockey finished undefeated and won the Skyland Division Championship; Boys Soccer captured the Skyland Conference Division Championship. Mr. Miller also congratulated the coaches for a great job.

Sixth grade student Mariah James provided the keynote address at the Somerset County Youth Council's Annual Youth Conference at Somerset Vo-Tech on November 12th.

Public Questions & Comments

1. Mr. Foglia said in recent years the Somerset Hills Educational Association has participated in NJEA climate surveys every three years and provided copies to the Board only.

- 2. Mrs. Cembrook, Bernardsville resident, thanked everyone who attended the Somerset Hills Athletic Foundation Fund fundraiser at the PAC Center. She also thanked all the people who helped with the event. Mrs. Cembrook spoke about B.H.S. student Anthony Virgilo who has planned an event to show the movie "Darin Goes West" about a young man with muscular dystrophy. It is a free event, but donations will be accepted.
- 3. Mr. DiGioacchino, Bernardsville resident, said he would like the Board to consider giving some of the savings from the use of the turf field to S.H.A.F.F. He continued that the parking lot is a lawsuit waiting to happen and the Board should do what is in the best interest of the students.
- 4. Janet Waite, Bernardsville resident, spoke about the middle school distribution of test scores. Mr. Miller addressed Mrs. Waite's questions.
