#### **Board Retreat**

A meeting was held on August 27, 2014, with the Board of Education and the superintendent for ethics training and to develop superintendent goals and board goals for 2014-2015.

- I. Gwen Thornton NJSBA
  - a. State of NJ:
    - i. The governor has reduced the percentage of students that will affect the teacher evaluation model
    - ii. There is concern that state funding for charter schools will have an impact on the amount public education receives.
    - iii. At this time there is no conversation about the Chapter 78 Healthcare law that will sunset on June 30, 2014.
  - b. Ethics training: completed and all board members that were in attendance signed the form and gave to the board secretary.

  - 1. 50% of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students will increase by at least one reading level as measured by the TCRWP reading assessment at the end of the year.
  - 2. Develop three benchmark assessments for grade 6 in the connected math program in order to measure the incremental growth and achievement of students in that grade level.
  - 3. Grades 5-8 social studies will achieve a mean SGO of greater than or equal to 3.25

- 4. Reorganize and support a new administrative structure to facilitate cohesive instructional leadership.
- 5. Conduct four parent workshops in the areas of math and literacy.

- 2. To review on a quarterly basis benchmark performance on superintendent merit and district goals.
