Featuring rhinestone costumes, seasoned instruments and tear-stained lyric sheets that take you on an entertaining journey through Country Music's past and present. See today's hit maker's, like Carrie Underwood, Taylor Swift, and Keith Urban alongside legends such as Johnny Cash, Reba McEntire and George Strait. After your visit to the Hall of Fame, enjoy shopping in downtown Nashville's **2nd Avenue and Broadway**. This historic district of downtown Nashville teems with life. Gourmet restaurants, coffee shops, gift shops, boutiques, souvenir shops and, of course, country and western apparel stores line 2nd Avenue and Broadway, offering a unique shopping experience.
